



**ACTION ALERT – HR 154 Ending the Medicare Disability Waiting
Period Act of 2007**

YOU can help make this legislation successful. H.R. 154 will improve title II of the Social Security Act by phasing out the 24-month waiting period for disabled individuals to become eligible for Medicare benefits, thus eliminating the waiting period for individuals with life-threatening conditions.

Presently there are an estimated seven million Americans under the age of 65 that are subject to the 24 month Medicare waiting period. Although some of these cases are able to find some form of health care coverage, 600,000 are currently uninsured. By eliminating the Medicare waiting period, this legislation would provide individuals with disabilities that are uninsured, access to the quality health care that will enable them to remain active, productive members of society.

**SAMPLE LETTER – DO NOT PRINT ON
ASSOCIATION/FOUNDATION LETTERHEAD**

Dear (Representative/Senator),

I am writing to ask you to cosponsor H.R. 154 Ending the Medicare Disability Waiting Period Act of 2007.

Currently there are 7 million disabled Americans under the age of 65 that are unable to receive the proper medical care due to the 24 month waiting period required under the current Medicare system. 600,000 are uninsured and many more are underinsured thus causing many to go into insurmountable debt.

H.R. 154 would phase this waiting period out of the next ten years thus giving these disabled Americans a fighting chance to once again become productive and useful members of society.

I suffer from Alpha-1 Antitrypsin Deficiency, also referred to as genetic emphysema. The symptoms of this disease usually present themselves between the third and fifth decade, so many of us fall subject to this 24 month waiting period and it's quite hard to hold your breath for that long.

So please support H.R.154 and let us breathe easier knowing that our voices are heard on Capitol Hill.
