- WHEREAS, Alpha-1 often goes undiagnosed, especially among individuals affected by chronic obstructive pulmonary disease, or misdiagnosed as asthma; and
- WHEREAS, treatment of alpha-1 antitrypsin deficiency, including medication, immunizations, and surgery, is designed to manage and relieve the symptoms associated with the liver and lung disease.
